### **Visiting Team Tickets Sales: Scrimmage will be free on a 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis**

- There will be 136 paired seats for visiting fans.
- There will also be 20 available spaces for personal lawn chairs that fans must bring themselves.
- Gates will open 30 mins prior to the start of the JV Scrimmage.
- Total Visitor Capacity 176.

### **Procedure:**

1. All spectators will be required to wear mask while entering the stadium. **(Administrator will oversee this)**
2. Visitor entrance and exit will be separate from stadium's main entrance.
3. All spectators will be required to answer Covid Questionnaire verbally prior to entering the stadium. **(Parent Volunteer will ask these questions)**
4. Any issues with temperature or Covid Questionnaire will be addressed by administrator.
5. Visitor team side has been marked with blue tape allowing the visitor side to sit with their pair while maintaining a safe distance from other visiting team fans. **DO NOT SIT ON BLUE TAPE.**
6. Hand Sanitizer will be provided at the visitor entrance and exit.

#### Coming in on I-37 S

Take exit 4A for TX-358 toward NAS-CCAD/Padre Island (0.3 mi) - Continue onto TX-358 E (5.3 mi) - Take the exit onto TX-286 S toward Crosstown Expy (1.0 mi) - Take the exit toward Saratoga Boulevard/TX-357 (0.3 mi) - Continue on Crosstown Access Rd to your destination (1.7 mi) - Merge onto Crosstown Access Rd (0.5 mi) - Turn left onto Saratoga Blvd (0.9 mi)

*Arrive at 3036 Saratoga Boulevard*

#### Coming in on US-77 S

Follow signs for Refugio/Corpus Christi - Continue onto US-77 BUS (4.1 mi) - Continue onto US-77 S (35.7 mi) - Get on TX-35 S in San Patricio County from FM 2678 S and FM136 S (29.2 mi) - Take US-181 S and TX-286 S to Crosstown Access Rd in Corpus Christi. Take the exit toward Saratoga Boulevard/TX-357 from TX-286 S (18.5 mi) - Continue on Crosstown Access Rd to your destination (1.7 mi) - Merge onto Crosstown Access Rd (0.5 mi) - Turn left onto Saratoga Blvd (0.9 mi)

*Arrive at 3036 Saratoga Boulevard*

#### Coming in on TX-44 E

Head east on TX-44 E/E Riley St toward N Texas Ave - Continue to follow TX-44 E (34.1 mi) - Slight right onto San Diego S (0.3 mi) - Turn right onto US-281 BUS S (1.2 mi) - Turn left onto Cecilia St (0.8 mi) - Continue onto FM 665 E (32.9 mi) - Continue straight onto FM 43 E (6.1 mi) - Turn left onto TX-286 N (1.0 mi) - Slight right onto Ayers St (0.9 mi) - Slight right toward Saratoga Blvd (190 ft) - Turn right onto Saratoga Blvd (0.6 mi)

#### Coming in on US-77 N

Continue on US-77 N - Turn right onto FM 665 E/Ave A - Continue to follow FM 665 E (13.0 mi) - Continue straight onto FM 43 E (6.1 mi) - Turn left onto TX-286 N (1.0 mi) - Slight right onto Ayers St (0.9 mi) - Slight right toward Saratoga Blvd (190 ft) - Turn right onto Saratoga Blvd (0.6 mi)

## **Team Bench and Warmups**

The visiting team bench is located on the south side of the game field. Your team will warmup on the east end of the game field. The east end is located closest to the field house and you will enter the field through the first set of gates as you approach from the field house.

## **Coaches and Videographer**

You will have spots reserved in the press box for 2 coaches. Home team will provide wide and tight film in order to provide enough social distancing space.

## **Bus and Parking**

As you arrive to the campus, follow the street light entrance. Turn at the first Right, passing the front of the school. Follow the loop and park at the building directly across from the tennis courts. The players and equipment may be unloaded there. The team and staff will be escorted to the locker room by one of our coaches.

### **Restrooms/Concessions**

Restrooms and concessions are located in the same building as the ticket booth and entrance.

**Visiting fans will be allowed but must maintain social distancing while wearing their mask.**

The Centurion Football Booster Club will have a concession stand selling food items, cold drinks, and snacks. All proceeds from the concession stand provide support for athletic programs at St John Paul II High School.

### **Emergency Procedures**

We are equipped with a lightning detection and warning system. The system is designed to detect the presence of lightning within an 8-mile radius of the campus. Should the system detect lightning, we will alert the head official.

In the event of impending lightening, the game announcer will direct everyone to exit the field and move to their vehicles or appointed locations.

- Teams and field crew will proceed to the locker rooms.
- Game Officials, spectators, cheer squads, bands, drill teams, etc. will go to their vehicles or to the CLC.

The game will be allowed to resume once 30 minutes has passed since the last lightning is detected. Everyone will then be allowed to return to the field.

The game officials are responsible for declaring a weather delay or cancellation.

Under our agreements with local Home Owners' Associations, no athletic activities are allowed past 10:30 PM and the lights are to be turned out by 11:00 PM.

### **Security**

STJPII will provide a uniformed officer to be on site before, during, and after the game. The officer(s) will assist with crowd and traffic control as well as on premises security.
